Cindy Day, representative from Caldwell Heritage Museum, requested \$300 from the Town for lighting at the Museum to ensure safety for guests and staff when leaving at night. The Council approved the request unanimously.

Debra Setzer, instructor at CCC&TI, requested \$300 from the Town for her students to attend the Biltmore in Asheville, NC. The Council approved the request unanimously.

Town Manager Shook presented an expenditure request of \$3,550 to repair a recently repaired sewer pump. Councilman Bolick explained the pump was damaged by shop rags dumped into the system. The Council approved the request unanimously.

Town Manager Shook presented the Council with the auditing contract presented by Boggs, Crump & Brown. The contract increased from \$7,475 to \$7,625. The Council agreed to the contract unanimously.

Town Manager Shook asked the Council to approve placing a request for qualifications from engineering firms. The RFQ, Shook explained, was for selecting an engineering firm to apply for outside wastewater funds and to implement the project to expand the sewer system. The Council agreed unanimously.
