Town Manager Shook presented the Council with an update on the Town's PARTF application. The Town was awarded the total grant request of \$43,575. Mayor Pro Tem Stewart informed the Council that he plans to work with the COG to make sure all grant guidelines are followed during the administration of the project. He has been in contact with playground contractors and with Erin Schotte, COG representative. He will present more as information becomes available.

Town Manager Shook presented the Council with a solid waste ordinance draft. The Council reviewed the draft with a change to Section II. The change substituted the term "automobiles" with motorized vehicles. This change was adopted to ensure boats, motorcycles, jet skies, and other non-automobiles were addressed by the ordinance. Councilman Robbins motioned to approve the agreement with a second from Mayor Pro Tem Stewart. The decision passed unanimously.

Administrative Reports and Updates

Town Manager Shook informed the Council he reconciled all delinquent sewer customers. All customers, except one that has yet to be reached, paid off their balances. No liens were placed on any sewer customer. The Council was delighted to hear the news.
